



CENTURY BATTERY WARRANTY TERMS & CONDITIONS

Official warranty reference for end users, dealers and warranty verification purposes.

Terms and Conditions of Warranty

This **CENTURY BATTERY** is fully guaranteed against material and workmanship defects. If the battery fails within the specified warranty period due to quality defects as inspected by authorized Century Motolite Battery Sdn. Bhd. Distributors and Representatives, and within the warranty limitations stated below, the battery will be replaced free of charge.

Warranty Period (From Date of Purchase or KM)

Vehicle Category	Warranty Period	Mileage Limit
Petrol Vehicles for Private Use	12, 15 or 18 months	25,000 KM (whichever comes first)
Diesel Vehicles for Private Use	6 months	20,000 KM (whichever comes first)
Taxi / Bus / Truck / Commercial Vehicles	6 months	20,000 KM (whichever comes first)

Note: The warranty period of the replacement battery will be computed as the warranty period of the original battery purchased, less the consumed service life of the original battery.

Warranty Limitations / Exclusions

- Battery fails because of overcharging or undercharging due to faulty charging or electrical system of the vehicle.
- Damage due to negligence of low usage (average <30 km per week), abuse, mishandling, accident and explosion.
- Damage due to fire, floods and other acts of nature.
- Any inadvertent or consequential damage arising from failure of battery.
- Tampering of labels, codes and other official markings will void the warranty.
- Transfer of ownership, or transfer of use to another vehicle.
- There is evidence that chemical additives were used or contamination is present in the electrolyte.
- The battery has been altered, modified or misused other than its original design and purpose.
- Prolonged vehicle storage resulting in battery failure.
- Battery of lower capacity and/or smaller size is used that is not recommended by the manufacturer, which will void the warranty.

Important

In making a warranty claim, you must bring your battery and the vehicle together with the dated sales invoice/receipt to the dealer where the battery was purchased. Warranty claims will not be entertained without valid documents as mentioned.

- Warranty is irreplaceable and non-transferable.
- Warranty is valid only in Malaysia.

Product Information and Care Instructions

- For Maintenance Free (MF) battery, never detach the lid sticker/label nor tamper with the electrolyte during the warranty period .
- Ensure correct polarity when installing your battery. Incorrect installation will damage your alternator and other auto-electrical system components. See package for details.
- Install battery cable terminals securely. Loose connections will lead to battery failure due to undercharging.
- Maintain appropriate battery clamping tightness.
- Refer to the vehicle manufacturer's recommendation for the correct battery size for your vehicle. Underrated battery will lead to shorter battery life.
